### WHERE & WHEN TO LOOK

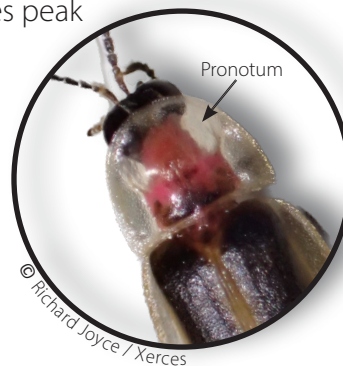
#### HABITAT

Native to the mangroves and salt marshes of Florida's coast



#### ADULT

- Adults may be found year-round: peak activity Mar–May
- Yellowish flashes peak 40-90 minutes after sunset
- Adults have a clear pronotum (head shield)



#### IMMATURE

Immature fireflies glow near the high tide line at night
